Christmas Club Share Accounts

It's that time of year again to think about your Christmas Club Account! October 1st -November 30th of each year, you are allowed to make as many withdrawals as needed to begin your Christmas shopping.

After November 30, 2014, only one withdrawal may be

made until October 1, 2015. A Christmas Club Share Account is a secondary savings account, in which you can deposit money into at any time, and has the same interest rate as your primary savings account. It's a great way to save money for the holiday season.

Credit Union Tip

Checks may clear your account at varying rates. Sometimes even immediately! Postdating a check does not guarantee the check will not clear your account earlier than you intended. The only

way to guarantee not to receive any overdraft fees is to verify the funds are available in your checking or primary savings account prior to writing the check.

Summer Activities

WHAT DOES MARQUETTE COMMUNITY FEDERAL CREDIT UNION DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. - Marquette Community Federal Credit Union has no affiliates
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. - Nonaffiliates we share with can include insurance companies, government agencies, plastic card processors (credit/debit/ATM), financial statement publishers or printers, mailhouse, mortgage companies, mortgage service companies, consumer reporting agencies, data processors, and check/share draft printers
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. - Our joint marketing partners include CUNA Mutual Group's MEMBERCONNECT

In order to update your address, we need a signature. We have address change forms available at the Credit Union. If you are unable to stop in to fill out a form, a

letter with your signature will work to update your address. Keeping your contact information updated is imperative for us to communicate important information. Furthermore, keeping your address updated will prevent you from accruing any bad address fees. A \$5.00 fee is assessed monthly to accounts with incorrect addresses.
