

Pin-Based Debit Transactions

You may now use your Visa debit card in the store and receive cash back. If you make a purchase and would like to receive cash back, select the 'debit' option on the pin pad after the card is swiped. You will be required to enter your 4 digit pin number and specify the amount of cash back desired. If you make a purchase and would not like to receive cash back or don't know your pin number, the 'credit' option is still available.

If you would like to make pin-based transactions and don't know your pin number, you may stop by the credit union with your picture ID and we can set you up with one. The daily dollar limit for cash withdraws will still apply at \$300.00 per 24 hours. Each business may have their own cash back limit.

Mick's Pick — Pecan Pumpkin Pie

Ingredients:

Pastry for single-crust pie (9 inches)

2 eggs

1 can (15oz) solid-packed pumpkin

1/2 cup maple syrup

1/4 cup sugar

1/4 cup heavy whipping cream

1 teaspoon ground cinnamon

1/2 teaspoon ground nutmeg

Topping:

2 eggs, lightly beaten

1 cup chopped pecans

1/2 cup sugar

1/2 cup maple syrup

Whipped topping, optional

Directions

- Line a 9-in pie plate with pastry; trim and flute edges. In a large bowl, beat the eggs, pumpkin, syrup, sugar, cream, cinnamon, and nutmeg until smooth; pour into pastry.
- For the topping, in a large bowl, combine the eggs, pecans, sugar and syrup; spoon over top.
- Bake at 425° for 15 minutes. Reduce heat to 350°. Bake 40-45 minutes longer or until crust is golden brown and top of pie is set.
- Cool on a wire rack for 1 hour. Refrigerate overnight or until set. Serve with whipped topping if desired. Yield: 8 servings.

If you plan to use your Visa Debit or ATM Card while traveling, please contact your credit union. We will notify you of any restrictions, and will keep note of your travel plans. Visa works hard to prevent fraudulent activity, in doing so they may block your card for unusual activity. Notifying your credit union will help prevent your card from being blocked while you are on vacation.

We also receive possible fraudulent activity alerts on our reports. If your account is flagged to have possible fraudulent activity, we will contact you to determine if the transaction(s) are legitimate. If we do not receive a response within a few business days, we will have to assume the transactions are fraud, and will be required to close your card. Our goal is to help prevent fraudulent activity and save you from as many inconveniences as possible.

Credit Union Tip

If you use your Visa debit card at a gas station and choose to pay at the pump, there is an automatic hold of \$50.00 – \$125.00 placed on your account. Gas stations are required by law to place a hold on your account, for the transaction is pre-authorized and they are unaware how much the actual purchase will be. The transaction will clear your account for the correct amount and the hold will drop off.
