Debit Card Breaches and Fraud

Recently our members have been affected by debit card breaches and fraudulent activity. Some card numbers that have been compromised due to recent data breaches also had fraud on them. It is our intent to keep our card member's accounts free of fraud and working to their full potential. Unfortunately, breaches and fraudulent activity seems to be running rampant. Therefore, we regrettably had to put temporary blocks on certain states. When traveling, it is advised to notify your credit union and have at least three methods of payment with you.

When a data breach happens, the credit union monitors all accounts very closely and diligently. We will only block a state if there has been confirmed fraud there. The credit union makes these decisions with everyone's best interest in mind. When fraud occurs on cards, the money is returned to each member after filling out the proper paperwork. This money comes from the credit union. In essence, you as a member are

paying for the fraud. For this reason we must block authorizations in states that have fraud, and close cards that have had fraud.

In the past 7 months, we have had 3 data breaches that have affected almost 3,000 cards. We do our best to notify each member to let them know that a card has been cancelled, but often find that we do not have correct phone numbers or cell numbers on file. Please always keep your phone number and contact information updated with us to help us notify you when a card is closed.

Data breaches are not the fault of your credit union, but from unsecure equipment at the merchant where you are swiping your card. Unfortunately by regulations, merchants don't have any financial responsibility for the breaches.

The new EMV chip card is in the early stages in the U.S. and we are looking into them as information becomes available.

Mick's Pick — Baked Potato Soup

Makes 10 to 12 Servings

Ingredients:

2 1/2 lbs Baby Red Potatoes

1/2 lb. Raw Bacon, Diced

1 Quart Water

1 Quart Milk

1 tsp Black Pepper

1/4 Cup Chopped Parsley

1 Cup Whipping Cream

1 Jumbo Yellow Onion, Diced

3 Stalks Celery, Diced

1/4 Cup Chicken Base

1 tsp Salt

3/4 Cup Flour

1 1/4 Sticks Margarine

Garnish: Shredded Colby Cheese, Bacon Bits, Chopped Green Onions



Instructions:

Boil potatoes in water for 10 minutes, drain and set aside.

In a large, heavy pot, sauté bacon, onions and celery over medium-high heat until celery is tender. Drain bacon grease and return bacon, onions, and celery to pot. Add in milk, water, chicken base, salt, and pepper. Heat over mediumhigh heat until very hot, but do not let it boil.

Melt margarine in a heave large saucepan over low heat. Stir in flour to make a roux. Mix well and allow to let bubble, stirring for 1 minute. If desired, a larger amount of roux can be made to produce a thicker soup.

Gradually add roux to soup, stirring constantly. Continue to cook, stirring until thick and creamy. Stir in potatoes, parsley and cream. Serve hot, garnished with cheese, bacon bits and green onion.
