MICK'S PICK

Mini Fruit Pizzas

Ingredients

- 1 package (16 oz) Pillsbury™ Ready
 To Bake!™ refrigerated sugar cookies
 (24 cookies)
- 1 package (8 oz) cream cheese, softened
- 2 tablespoons frozen limeade concentrate
- 1/2 cup powdered sugar
- 3 cups fresh blueberries, sliced strawberries and kiwifruit

Steps

- 1. Bake cookies as directed on package. Cool completely, about 10 minutes.
- 2. Meanwhile, in medium bowl, beat cream cheese, limeade concentrate and powdered sugar with electric mixer on medium speed until smooth.
- 3. Spread each cookie with 1 tablespoon cream cheese mixture. Arrange sliced fruit on top of each cookie. Serve immediately, or cover and refrigerate up to 2 hours before serving. Sprinkle with powdered sugar just before serving.
